MANAGER'S CORNER:

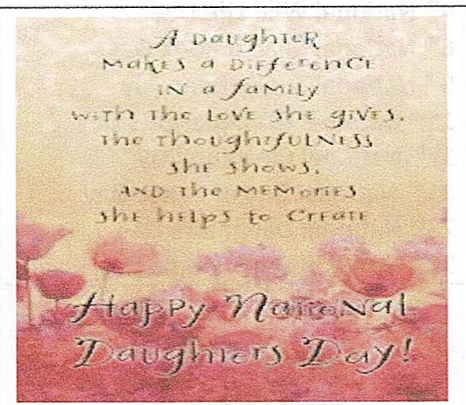
We would like to thank everyone for not using the irrigation water during this time that the well has been very low. We are sorry for the inconvenience. We can only hope next year we have more water.

Inside:

- Clean out dryer exhaust tubes & vents
- Get your furnace serviced and replace filters
- Drain sediment from hot water heater
- Test smoke & carbon monoxide detectors and replace batteries in them
- Vacuum condenser coils on refrigerators

Outside:

- Check weather stripping & caulking around doors & windows
- Check & clean gutters & downspouts
- Drain & store garden hoses
- Install insulation covers over exterior spigots
- Drain gas from lawn mowers before storing them

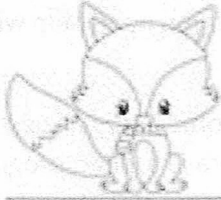

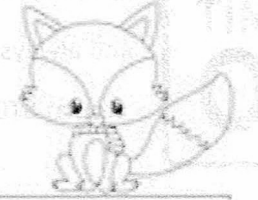

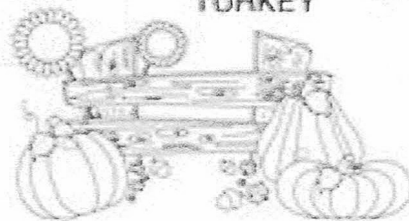
