Who Invented Santa Claus?

The legend of Santa Claus can be traced back to a monk named St. Nicholas who was born in Turkey around 280 A.D.. St. Nicholas gave away all of his inherited wealth and traveled the countryside help the poor and sick, becoming known as the protector of children and sailors.

St. Nicholas first entered American popular culture in the late 18th century in New York, when Dutch families gathered to honor the anniversary of the death of "Sint Nikolaas" (Dutch for Saint Nicholas) "Sinter Klaas" for short. "Santa Claus" draws his name from this abbreviation.

Just a Reminder if you haven't already, now is a good time to get a flu shot.

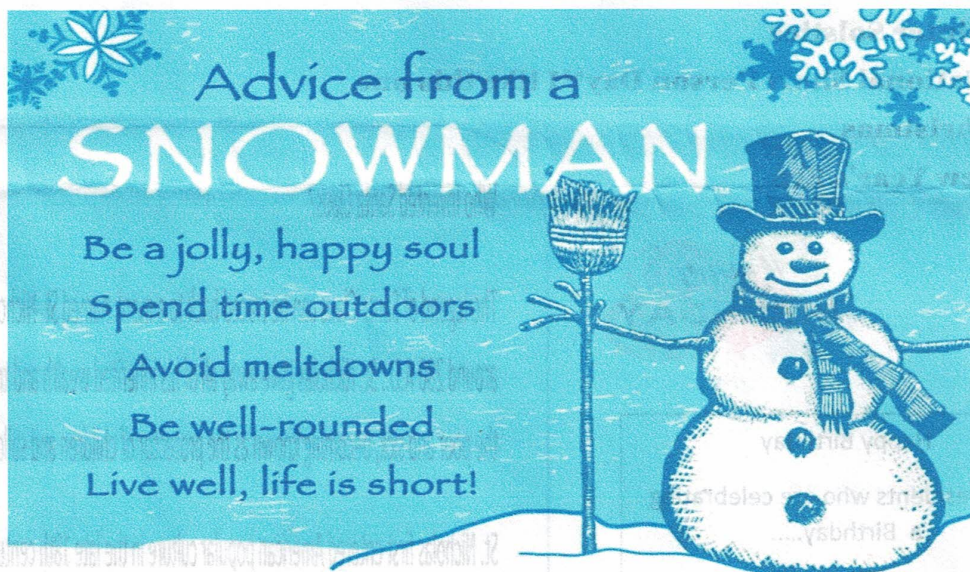
Leaves are falling it is the time of year for yard clean-up. Please help keep the leaves cleaned up in your yard. That will help with all the leaves that end up on the road.
