MANAGER'S CORNER:

Reminder if your mobile home insurance has expired and just renewed, please bring the office a copy of your renew letter. I will be sending out letters to those that have expired or have not given me a copied of the mobile insurance. This is a requirement of the park.

Reminder about Parking: You are allowed 2 vehicles per home site. If you have more than 2 vehicles, you must remove one for the park or rent and extra space by RV parking. The NO PARKING ON STREET OVER NIGHT is being enforced. Vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense.

We will be resuming the replacing the water meters on all the homes in the community within the next couple months. Some have already been changed. We will notify in advance when your street is being done. Unfortunately, they are not electronically read, so reading will still be door to door.

The recycle company will not pick up boxes that are not broken down and placed inside the recycle containers. So, please brake boxes down and not sit them on top of recycle containers.

The free table has been doing really good for the most part, some are still placing items that are not in good shape or clean.

Top Tips for Fire Safety

☑ Install smoke alarms on every level of your home, inside bedrooms and outside sleeping areas.

☑ Test smoke alarms every month. If they're not working, change the batteries. If the smoke alarm is older than 10 years, it should be replaced.

☑ Talk with all family members about a fire escape plan and practice the plan twice a year.

☑ If a fire occurs in your home, GET OUT, STAY OUT and CALL 911. Never go back inside for anything or anyone.

Did you know that if a fire starts in your home, you may have as little as two minutes to escape? During a fire, early warning from a working smoke alarm plus a fire escape plan that has been practiced regularly can save lives. Learn what else to do to keep your loved ones safe!
