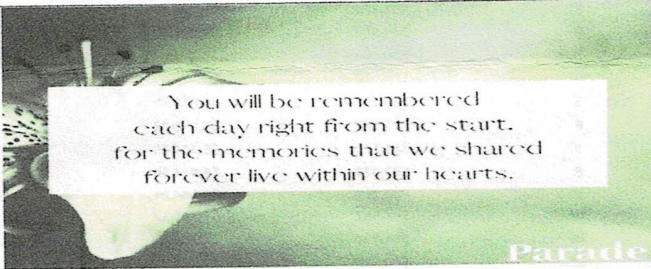

MANAGER'S CORNER:
